Guidelines for Conference Submission

Abstract

Times bold, clear, descriptive and no longer than 200 words

Conference Paper

Times bold, clear, relevant and thought provoking to conference theme and no longer than 10 pages including references.

Keywords

Three to five words.

Introduction

Visit to the topic proving rational on the current need and future prospects.

Methods

Comply with the accepted norms in practice, nationally and globally.

Font and Spacing

The font used throughout the paper is Times Roman. The paper size is A4 (i.e., 210 x 297mm), two-column format with a 2.5cm margin at the top, a 3cm margin at the bottom, 1.5cm margins on the left and right with a 1cm space between the two columns. Lines are singlespaced (or 12pt). If the last page of your paper consists of less than two columns, then divide the text into two columns of equal length. Use high-quality paper, and print on one side only with, preferably, a laser printer. Page number should be written on the back of pages in light pencil and are not to be included in the text.

Sequentially numbered in numeric fashion along with title and number.

Sequentially numbered in numeric fashion.

Footnotes

Placed at the bottom of the column in which they appear in 9pt times bold.

Optional.
